




#### **State Goals**





# **ADVANCED COURSEWORK**

ACE is enthusiastically pursuing Advanced Placement®and other options for Rhetoric students to gain college credits prior to graduating from ACE. Some classes may have pre-requisites. When students meet the pre-requisites. ACE provides a weekend retreat to prepare for the exams and pays the exam fees. Currently our school offers AP Environmental Science, AP US History, AP Language & Composition, AP Psychology, and AP Latin. Students needing AP classes not on the roster can often receive the classes on an individual basis through certified and trained teachers.

# **CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION**

ACE allows students to pursue career and technical education through the local colleges, businesses, and online classes. Students' class expenses can be reimbursed when specific criteria is met. Graduating students who meet their personal goals is the desire and intent of the individualized CTE outreach program we utilize.

# **EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

Students are encouraged to develop individual interests through our Supplemental Instructional program. Activities such as creative arts, dance, music, and sports are included in the school's program and students register for the classes that best fit their needs and schedules. ACE also participates in student council, National Honors Society, community character projects, and outdoor school.
