Communication regarding communicable disease transmission



Our school monitors absenteeism. When we see a high rate of absenteeism in our school connected to communicable diseases, we will notify parents via email to:

- Make aware the level of communicable disease circulating in our community.
- Ask families to watch for symptoms of illness and stay home when ill.
- Suggest actions that can prevent the continued transmission of disease.

The Opportunity Strengthen health & safety in our school



During times of high communicable disease transmission, our school will implement protocols to create and maintain safe environments that keep our students learning in-person. This will include:

- Reteaching and encouraging handwashing.
- Disinfecting and sanitizing surfaces.
- Suggesting face coverings and diagnostic testing while a respiratory outbreak is active.
